- 2. What are the core values that we agree are central to our purpose?
- 3. Given the legacy of our founder, our values, and our traditional giving, what are the components of a mission statement that would best express how we see our common, philanthropic purpose or reason for being?
- 4. How can we best use this statement in the future? How can it be an active guide, rather than a piece of paper sitting on a shelf?
- 5. Who should see it? Is it internal or external? If it is for public use, how should we publicize it?
- 6. How often should we review this statement? What are our guidelines for revisiting it in the future?
