




## Background


- 79 community foundations with assets of over \$200 million were invited to participate in an online survey to help inform the program for the 2016 convening of community foundation senior leadership
- Responses were collected via Surveymonkey.com in March-May 2016
- 31community foundations responded to the survey and their answers are summarized on the following slides
- When analyzing and synthesizing the results of this survey, duplicate answers from the same foundation were eliminated



## Some of the issues that emerged in the survey results include:

- How to effectively track and report impact in a way that attracts significant support
- Alternate staffing models (e.g., foundations where silos have been eliminated, matrixed team work by staff, etc.)
- Finding the balance between donor leadership and community leadership while simultaneously being able to meet the greatest needs of the community and serve donors
- Recognizing that the "one size fits all" model does not work for community foundations and seeking synergy at foundations of differing asset size and geography
