## 10 Tips & Tools to Improve Meetings & Navigate Uncomfortable Conversations

- 1. Get curious not furious.
- 2. Frame discussions and decisions to be made properly (use an agenda that specifies topic, length, type of conversation and intended outcome).
- 3. Get clear on who needs to be in the room to serve the purpose, decision, conversation. Then stick to it!
- 4. Be the thermostat not the thermometer (set the tone and temperature; don't reflect it).
- Establish and enforce board norms.
- 6. Evaluate each Board meeting (see <u>Practitioner's Guide to Governance as Leadership</u>).
- 7. Use a Parking Lot or Bike Rack (Record discussion visually people fear things will be forgotten if they don't see them).
- 8. Summarize and reinforce each discussion What did we decide, agree on? What are the action items and next steps?
- 9. Vary options for input (e.g., polling during meetings or surveys before meetings anonymous, avoids "anchoring" to most influential voices).
- 10. Use committees effectively.
