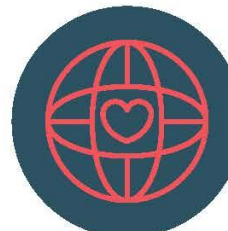

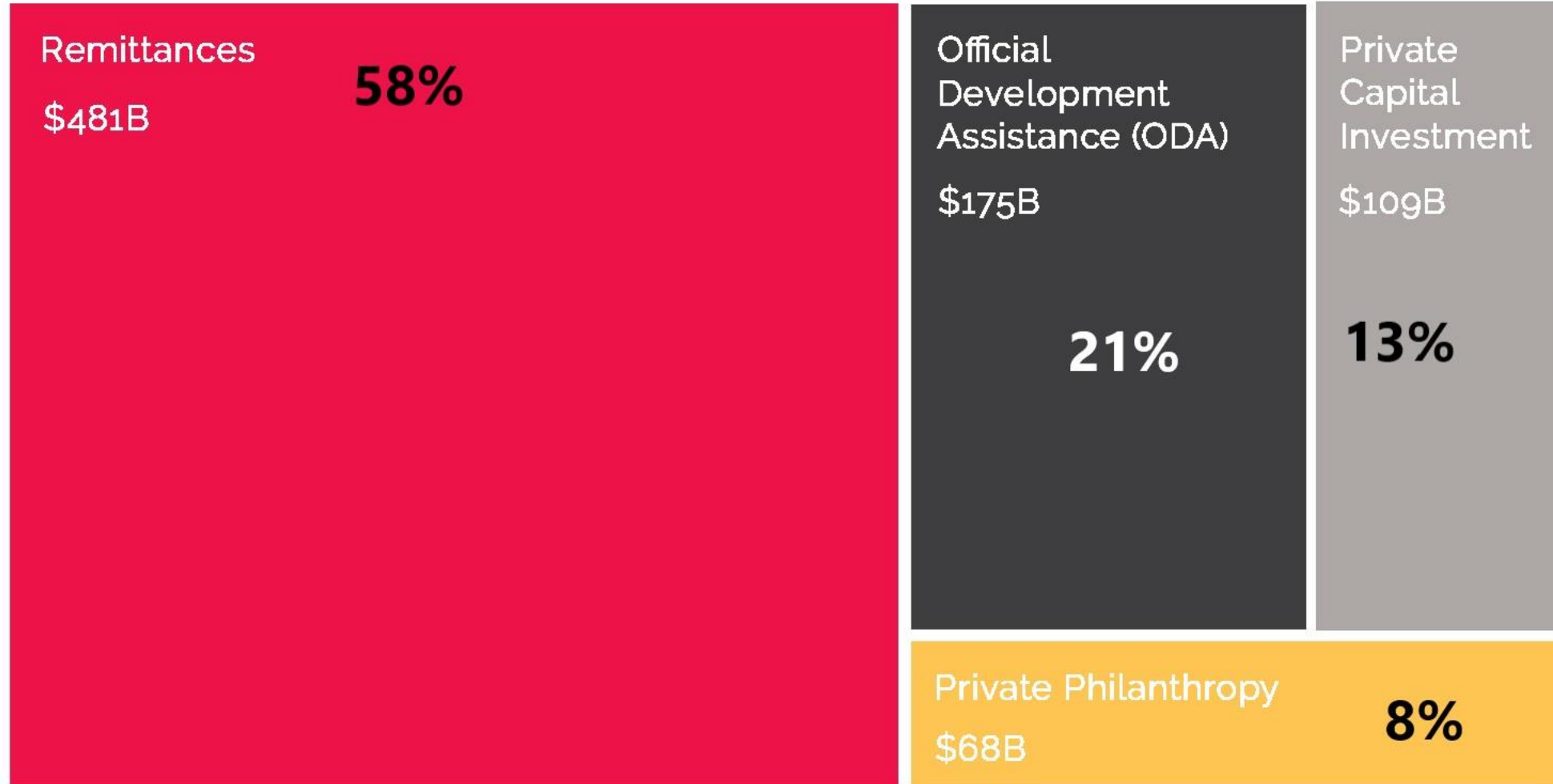

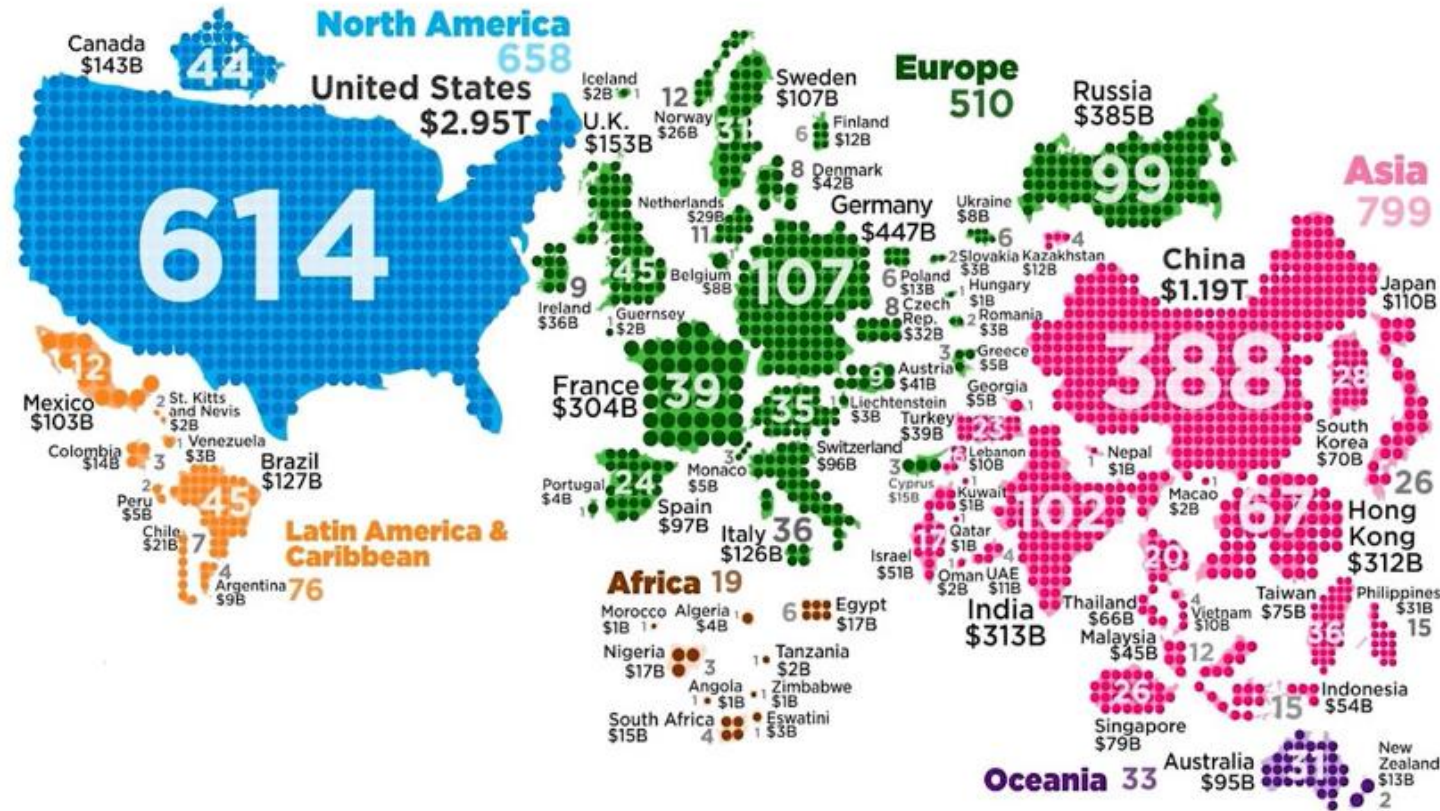

World Map of Billionaires 2020



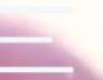

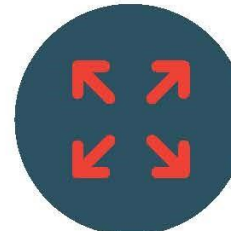

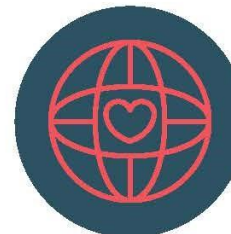
